## **CAS REQUIREMENTS**

As a core component of the IB Diploma, the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) program must be successfully completed, in order to qualify for the Diploma.

## What are the requirements?

In order to meet the requirements for CAS to qualify for the IB Diploma, you must:

- Have eighteen (18) months of ongoing engagement at three (3) to four (4) hours per week, on average demonstrated through meaningful reflection.
- Have a relative balance between Creativity, Activity and Service
- Have a least one major project:
  - o Long-term
  - Collaborative
  - o Crossing at least two areas of <u>Creativity</u>, <u>Activity</u> and <u>Service</u>.
- Address all of the learning objectives (Note: This means discussing them in detail—not simply naming them.) including the following:
  - What was happening and what were you doing?
  - o What issue arose?
  - o How did you react / solve the issue?
  - o What did you LEARN about [the LO: *Ie:* what specifically did you learn about your own personal strengths? *This is referring to personal development—skills are a different LO.*]
- Successfully complete a detailed portfolio that gives a clear depiction of what you have accomplished and how you have grown personally, through CAS.
- Successfully complete all of the required interviews.
